

Make a Resurrection Garden

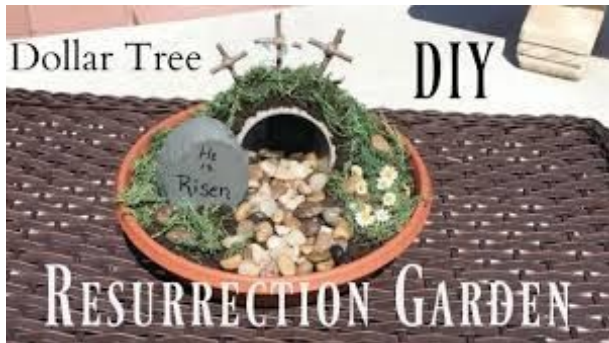
The Easter Story:

(Recorded in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.) Choose one of the Gospels and read about the following events:

- The Last Supper: Matthew 26:17-30, Mark 14:12-25, Luke 22:7-23
- Judas Betrays Jesus: John 18:1-13, Luke 22:1-6, Luke 22:47-54, Matthew 26:47-56, Mark 14:43-50
- Crucifixion of Jesus: Matthew 27:1-54, Mark 15:1-40, Luke 23:1-48, John 19:1-30
- Resurrection of Jesus: Matthew 28, Mark 16, Luke 24, John 20

Examples of resurrection gardens:



Possible materials:

- For ground: large dish or plate with pebbles, soil, dirt, flowers, cacti plants
- For tomb: potato, small flower pot, rock, plastic cup
- For decoration: stick crosses with twine, soldier figurines, "He is Risen" sign

Directions:

1. Fill a plate or dish with dirt or soil. Add plants, grass, pebbles, and branches.
2. Create the tomb by using a cup or pot with a large rock in front of it that can be rolled away.
3. Add decorations like three crosses, soldier figurines, or a sign.
4. Read the story of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection and celebrate by rolling the stone away from the tomb!
