Minimizing Risk

In order to minimize the risk to our children, staff, and community you can expect the following for the 2020-2021 school year:

- Maximum class size of 10 kids
- Maximum school size of 40 kids and 4 classroom teachers
- Daily cleaning of learning spaces
- Minimum of 1 hour of outside time daily to get fresh air (spaced throughout school day)
- Training for all families and staff on how to keep immune system functioning at its best
- Healthy children and staff, free of symptoms, will attend the school day (All others will be asked to take "healing days" at home until it is appropriate for them to return to school)
- Families have the personal choice of sending their child to school in a face mask
- Appropriate hand washing throughout the day

Maximizing the Educational Experience

We care deeply about the complete health of your child, his/her strength of mind, spiritual maturity, and body function, because ultimately it determines the kind of person he/she becomes and his/her impact on this world. While we could continue to isolate our children and

engage in a digital curriculum, we know that this is not optimal for the growth and development of a child. Next school year, we will continue to hold firmly to our three, essential initiatives:

- Instilling a kingdom mindset- We will continue to point our kids towards a relationship with Christ that inspires a deep love for those around us and an attitude of grace and humility.
